Ypsomed notes SWX reprimand – no influence on net profit

Burgdorf, 17 January 2008, 07:30am – Ypsomed Holding AG has taken due note of the reprimand published today against the company by the SWX. The SWX Swiss Exchange complained deficiencies of IFRS accounting standards in connection with the consolidated financial statements for the business year 2005/06 (1 April 2005 to 31 March 2006). The accounting deficiencies noted by the SWX Swiss Exchange relate to the way in which prepayments made by customers were stated in the accounts as intangible assets and to the presentation of transactions with marketable securities in the cash flow statement. Ypsomed has already restated and adjusted the presentation of the balance sheet and cash flow statement for the business year 2005/06 in its annual report for 2006/07 in agreement with SWX.

“The issues raised by the SWX were already fully corrected in the annual report for 2006/07 and – as already communicated when the annual results were published on 29 May 2007 – have no influence on the net profit of Ypsomed”, said CEO Richard Fritschi.
